- **For Mathematics lessons**, students will need to use a scientific calculator. Casio fx82AU Plus is recommended and can be purchased from the front office for \$19. The classroom teacher will refer to this calculator in class.
- It should be noted that not **all** calculators are approved for use in public examinations. Students and parents should check details with the Mathematics Department prior to purchase.
- The Mathematics Department cannot provide calculators for students, so it is required that students equip themselves. Care should be exercised in the security of calculators.
- The office have suitable calculators for sale to students.
- Compulsory Text Book covers (to help prevent damage) are available from the maths department, payment of \$4.00 should be paid to the front office. Please mark all equipment clearly with the student's name including calculators.
